- The loss of life in the suicide blast outside the airport in Kabal resulted in the loss of life for 13 service personal of our military along with the loss of people unfortunate to be in the area at the time. We grieve for their families.
- A 7.2 magnitude earthquake in Haitai wreaking devastation and killing over 2,000 people.
- Hurricane Ida coming 16 years after Katrina in the Gulf of Mexico has devastated many lives and infrastructure.
- Forest fires continue to destroy so much in their wake as they create an Armageddon effect resulting in flooding and loss of property.

• The Covid pandemic continues to rear its ugly head again affecting people as it also creates division on how to respond.

How does one truly make a difference?

I find it helpful to pray, expressing my frustration to God even as I request help and wisdom in how to best respond.

GRIEFSHARE BEGINS SEPTEMBER 8




GriefShare, begins Wednesday, September 8, 1:30 pm in Room 4, facilitated by Pastor David Holling.



PEANUT BUTTER PIE XV



INGREDIENTS

- 1 (9 inch) prepared graham cracker crust
- 1 cup heavy whipping cream
- 1 (10 ounce) package peanut butter chips
- 2 ounces smooth peanut butter
- 🗌 2 teaspoons vanilla extract 💡 🔐
- 2 cups heavy whipping cream
- ☐ ¼ cup white sugar
- ☐ ½ cup chocolate syrup

Directions



Place 1 cup of cream in a small saucepan. Heat to just below the boiling point. Place peanut butter chips, peanut butter, and vanilla extract in food processor. With processor running, slowly drizzle hot cream down pouring chute. Process until mixture is completely smooth. Set aside to cool.

Step 2

In a large bowl, whip cream until soft mounds form. Slowly add sugar while continuing to beat, until cream forms stiff peaks. Gently fold in cooled peanut butter mixture. Do not incorporate completely; leave some white streaks in mixture.

Step 3

Pour mixture into graham cracker crust and chill at least 6 hours. Drizzle each plate with chocolate syrup before serving.
