WORLD COMMUNION SUNDAY

October 6th is World Communion Sunday. We are called to reach out to all people and model the diversity of all God's children. Your generous gifts support racial and ethnic students in achieving their educational goals while also transforming communities.

Fifty percent of the offering provides scholarships for graduate students from the U.S. and other countries. Thirty-five percent supports ethnic scholarships for



undergraduate students. Fifteen percent funds In-Service Training Programs for racial and ethnic persons. Special Offering envelopes are available in the Narthex, Lindsay Hall and the Church Office.



NAME BADGES




We are still taking orders for new name badges! They are \$10 each to cover a part of the expense.

Study books are available in class. We have a great time with our teachers!




THE UPPER ROOM SEPT - OCT
