ANNUAL CONFERENCE HIGHLIGHTS 2025



• The June 2025 Annual Conference drew United Methodist leaders from

across Arizona and southern Nevada, under **Bishop Carlo A. Rapanut**, who continues to lead the Desert Southwest Conference.
Held in Las Vegas, part of the North District of the Desert Southwest Conference, the event reinforced the conference's mission: *making disciples of Jesus for the transformation of the world* through equipping local leaders through the theme, "A Healthy Church for a Healthy World...and Let It Begin with Me."

- We heard reports from around the conference, voted on legislation and the annual budget for the conference, engaged in worship (including opening worship with a local Elvis singing gospel songs, and ordained new clergy. In total, 4 individuals were ordained as elders, 5 were commissioned as provisional members, and 1 was recognized as an associate member. It is safe to claim that our conference is the only conference to claim that Elvis participated in worship!
- The Mission Project for 2025, focused on food insecurity in the Las Vegas area. The Desert Southwest Conference gave \$28,524.40, just shy of its \$30,000 goal. Sun Lakes UMC supported this effort with _____ from our benevolence fund.
- Part of the conference was spent in workshops and speakers, including Kara Lassen Oliver, the Executive Director of St. Mary's Sewanee. Oliver invite the annual conference to root their faith not in striving or performance, but in personal, embodied practices that sustain the spirit in a vulnerable world. She emphasized **four spiritual practices**: claiming belovedness; deep listening; choosing joy intentionally; and metabolizing trauma through embodied disciplines. The session closed with a communal body prayer that affirmed faith begins with wholeperson presence.
- During the final session of the conference, which took place on Sunday morning, the Bishop "fixed" the appointments, announcing all persons appointed to serve churches and beyond in the Desert Southwest Conference. Pastor Chan and I were both reappointed to Sun Lakes UMC for the coming year.
- As Pastor Chan and I begin the new appointment year, we look forward to serving in ministry with you. May the next twelve months help us engage in the challenge of being a healthy church for a healthy world... for it begins with us.

NAME BADGES




We are still taking orders for new name badges! They are \$10 each to cover a part of the expense.
